The Clubhouse Community of Hope

The comprehensive community-based program is for adults living with persistent mental illness. The Clubhouse offers a collaborative, restorative environment where members can participate in a Monday-Friday voluntary day program, recovering by gaining access to opportunities for employment, socialization, education, skill development, housing and improved overall wellness. The Clubhouse mission is to provide a safe and thriving place where members are filled with hope as they rediscover their ability to LIVE, LAUGH, LOVE and LEARN.

DID YOU KNOW??? ONE IN FOUR people around the world suffer from mental disorders - more than cancer, diabetes or heart disease.

Public Education Partners of Aiken County (PEP)

Public Education Partners of Aiken County (PEP) is dedicated to the advancement of quality in education for all students in Aiken County Public Schools. PEP provides avenues for community involvement in public education through opportunities for personal participation in school programs. PEP is celebrating 30 years of connecting educators and students, with Aiken's business leaders, service organizations and individuals who recognize strong public schools are the foundation for the future of Aiken County.

DID YOU KNOW??? 64% of Aiken County public school students are considered Pupils in Poverty (PIP). The PIP index is 76.5% of students in Aiken Elementary schools. Both levels exceed South Carolina's average.

PEP is focused on three pillars key to student success: Literacy, STEAM and Teacher Support. PEP is working to improve literacy in Aiken County by encouraging the love of reading through book ownership. The *Diana Floyd* "My Own Book" Program enables ALL 1,742 of Aiken County's third-grade students across 21 schools to participate in their school's book fair by providing \$15 vouchers so that they may choose and purchase their own book. In its 2 years, the program has placed an incremental 5,000+ in student households

PEP plans to expand students' school experience in STEAM related programs. The "PEP STEM KIT" program will provide new STEM kits to elementary schools to allow students critical hands-on experience with a range of science projects. This program is designed to bring in volunteers from Aiken businesses to increase awareness of how science is applied and exposure to different careers.



To support teachers, PEP awards Teacher Classroom Innovation Grants. These grants recognize their drive to try new methods and expand resources for their students. As school budgets tighten, these funds from the community become even more important.
